



Phoenix Youth Center Rules of Conduct

1. Persons must be in grades 3-9.
2. Persons must sign in and out every day (maximum of 2 times).
3. Persons are responsible for cleaning up after themselves.
4. The Phoenix Youth Center is not responsible for items which are lost or stolen. Items in the lost and found for more than two weeks will be donated to Jubilee.
5. Persons that are engaging in activities at the Phoenix Youth Center are expected to be respectful of each other, the staff, the equipment, and the facilities.
6. ABSOLUTELY NO tobacco, tobacco like substances, alcohol or drugs.
7. No physical fighting, confrontations or play-fighting.
8. The following behaviors are not tolerated: name calling, intimidating, bullying, swearing, obscene gestures, physical contact, fighting, racial remarks, or defacing of property.
9. Voices must be kept at a conversational level.
10. No loitering in municipal building or on municipal property.
11. Center phone can only be used to call home.
12. PDA (Public Displays of Affection) will not be tolerated.
13. No gambling.
14. Weapons, and anything deemed dangerous or inappropriate by the Youth Center staff will not be allowed.

Breaking a rule will result in two warnings followed by suspension from the Phoenix Youth Center for the duration of the day.
